Sunday School starts! There will be a picnic with hot dogs and and ice cream Sundae bar. Sign up sheets will


be posted for side dishes. Please reserve the date and join us as we welcome everyone back!

Some of you may remember Harold Tindall and some may have never met him but Harold was a long time member of church who moved to Iowa after the death of his beloved wife Jean, to be near his son Dan. Harold recently shared an article from the Mayflower Log, where he currently resides and we thought we would share what Harold has been up to. Harold said; "During my lifetime, I've ridden on many things: a trike, a bike, a car, a tractor, a truck, a helicopter, large and small airplanes, buses and trains." A long time ago he had a discussion with his son, Dan about how he would like to go for a balloon ride on his 100th

birthday.



Well neither Harold or Dan forgot the wish for a balloon ride. When Harold's 100th birthday finally came in September of 2014, it was not a good day. Harold says, "It was too windy". The balloon owner and driver would not take a chance on taking Harold up, especially in light of his advanced years. So, Harold and Dan waited.

Finally, on October 6, 2015, one month past Harold's 101st birthday, weather conditions were perfect. They watched the balloon get inflated and then got into the rather small basket with four other people. There was no door latch on the basket. The riders climbed on a step stool to get in. Harold needed a little assistance in that process, but it went smoothly. He was excited, the sun was shining, and there was almost no wind as the balloon slowly rose in the sky. Harold

said it was utterly quiet and so beautiful up in the air. He could see the straw colored corn fields neatly laid out in squares and rectangles in green fields and cars looked like ants. He could see the sharp division of the land and sky at the horizon. "It was Beautiful." he said. He thoroughly enjoyed his 45 minutes high in the air. What are his plans for his 102nd birthday, he is not saying but his attitude said **almost anything is possible at any age.**
