Because the church is looking for a stated supply pastor, the Session prepared a Ministry Information Form that is in the PC(USA) search program; reviewed dozens of Personal Information Forms from prospective candidates; listened to sermons; checked references. Interviews have been completed and we are in the process of getting Presbytery approval for the chosen candidate.


